HARRY CULPAN, of Beech Lea, Skipton, in the County of York, Gentleman.

2. The said property is hereby vested in the said body corporate and persons for all the estate and interest therein belonging to or held in trust for the Charity.

Land containing 211 square yards or thereabouts situate at Ovenden in the County Borough of Halifax and having on the east a frontage of 141 feet or thereabouts to Old Lee Bank Road on the north a frontage of 123 feet or thereabouts to Batley Street and on the west a frontage of 154 feet or thereabouts to Melbourne Street being the land comprised in the above-mentioned conveyance dated the 15th January 1871 made between John Ingham of the first part and William Wilson and twenty others of the second part and enrolled in the High Court of Chancery on the 22nd March 1871 with the buildings since erected thereon known as the Lee Mount Baptist Chapel and Schoolrooms.
