of Trustees.

CHARITY COMMISSION.

In the matter of the Charity of Frederic Ingham for
North Parade Baptist Chapel, at Halifax, in the
West Riding of the County of York, which Charity
was founded by will proved in the Principal
Registry on the 12th May 1920; and
In the matter of the Charities Act, 1960.

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HEREBY
ORDER that the following Scheme be approved and established
as the Scheme for the regulation of the above-mentioned
Charity:-

S C H E M E.

1. Administration of Charity. - The above-mentioned
Charity and the endowments thereof specified in the schedule
hereto and all other the endowments (if any) of the Charity
shall be administered and managed subject to and in
conformity with the provisions of this Scheme.

2. Investment. - The sum of stock specified in the
said schedule shall be transferred into the name of the
Official Custodian for Charities.

3. Division of endowments. - The endowments of the
Charity shall be divided forthwith as near as may be into
three equal parts.

4. Separate Charities. - (1) One third part shall
constitute henceforth the endowment of a separate Charity
which shall be called the Charity of Frederic Ingham for
Pellon Baptist Chapel (hereinafter referred to as the
Pellon Charity).

(2) A further third part shall constitute henceforth
the endowment of a separate Charity which shall be called
the Frederic Ingham Charity for Lee Mount Baptist Chapel
(hereinafter referred to as the Lee Mount Charity).

(3) The remaining third part shall constitute henceforth
the endowment of a separate Charity which shall be called
the Frederic Ingham Charity for Rishworth Baptist Chapel
(hereinafter referred to as the Rishworth Charity).

PELLON CHARITY.

5. Trustees. - The Deacons for the time being of the Baptist Chapel at Pellon in the County Borough of Halifax by virtue of their respective offices shall be the Trustees of the Pellon Charity.

6. Application of income. - The Trustees of the Pellon Charity shall apply the clear income thereof in or towards defraying the cost of the repair and upkeep of the said Baptist Chapel at Pellon and the maintenance of the services therein.

LEE MOUNT CHARITY.

7. Trustees. - The Deacons for the time being of the Baptist Chapel at Lee Mount in the said County Borough by virtue of their respective offices shall be the Trustees of the Lee Mount Charity.

8. Application of income. - The Trustees of the Lee Mount Charity shall apply the clear income thereof in or towards defraying the cost of the repair and upkeep of the said Baptist Chapel at Lee Mount and the maintenance of the services therein.

RISHWORTH CHARITY.

9. Trustees. - The Deacons for the time being of the Baptist Chapel at Rishworth in the Urban District of Ripponden by virtue of their respective offices shall be the Trustees of the Rishworth Charity.

10. Application of income. - The Trustees of the Rishworth Charity shall apply the clear income thereof in or towards defraying the cost of the repair and upkeep of the said Baptist Chapel at Rishworth and the maintenance of the services therein.

11. Questions under Scheme. - Any question as to the construction of this Scheme or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme shall be determined by the Charity Commissioners upon such application made to them for the purpose as they think sufficient.
