SUGGESTIONS.

Whilst the Musical success of the Commemoration depends very largely upon the care and attention bestowed on Rehearsals, all who sing (and it is desirable that all present should sing), are reminded that a further measure of success may be attained by attention to the following suggestions.

1st.—Immediately that a roll on the drums calls attention, let all conversation cease.

2nd.—Whatever position you are in, turn at once to face the Orchestra.

3rd.—Stand erect: or, if obliged to sit, do so in a position as upright as possible.

4th—Hold your book high. (Dr. Browne, Surgeon to the Albert Hall Choral Society, says it ought to be on a level with the eye). It should be held as high as is practicable without hiding the Conductor from view.

5th—Do not be content to be guided by those who happen to be singing near you—look straight to the Conductor, and sing neither before, nor after, his indications, but exactly *with* them. *Never loose sight of his movements.* The difficulties in the way of controlling so vast an assembly are immense; but the greatest of them all is *inattention*. For the purposes of expression the time will be quickened or slackened in accordance with the character of the words or music: and thus the undivided attention of all is essential

6th.—Study the words of the hymns. Master their sentiments before the day of Commemoration, and then you will be able to join, not with the voice only, but with the heart and the understanding.

It may be useful to some to point out with what movement of the Conductor's bâton each tune and chorus begins.

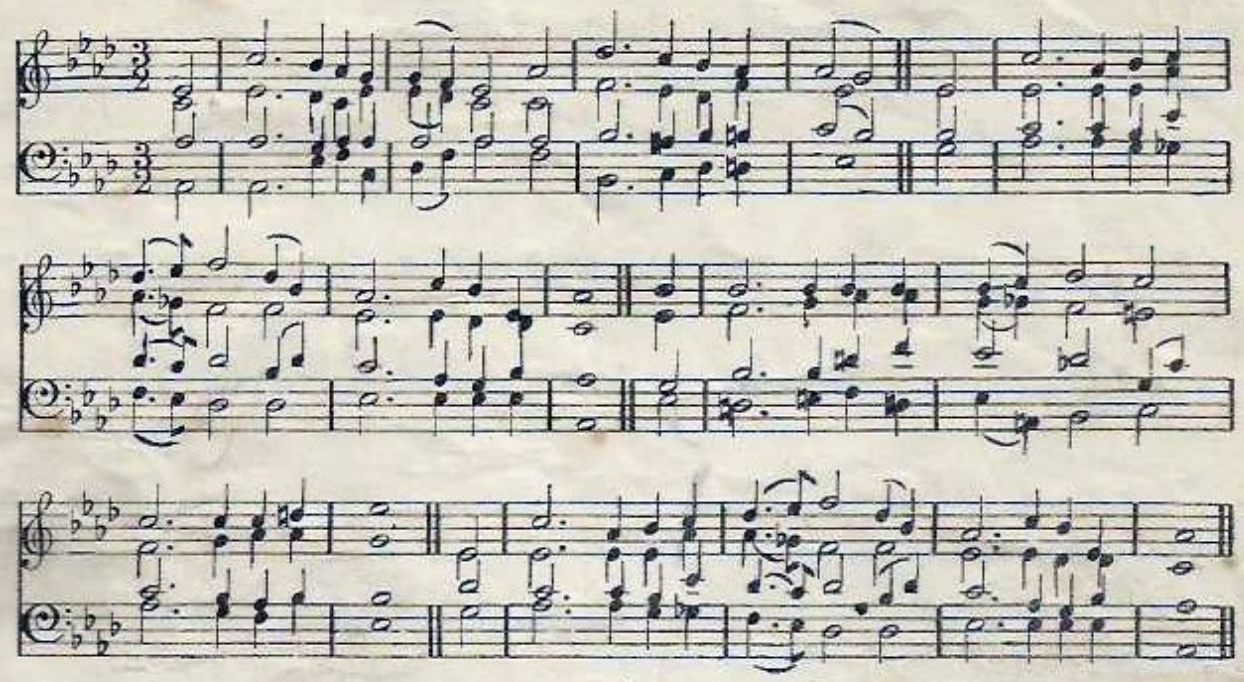
