Richard Horsfall Nursery Lane to light the fires for which he is to have a collection every 3 Months

Henry Cockroft Superintendent this office to be held only 3 Month

Female visitors: Susan Marshall
Nany Pollard

Male visitors: Zachariah Greenwood
James Clegg junior

John and Thomas Clegg appointed to visit all our Teachers who do not attend and request them to fill up their respective places.

School meeting August 19th 1849

First every Class is supplied with a teacher
And it is now expected that every teacher
will attend to their duty and the school
begin to prosper

2nd John and Thomas Clegg were requested to see Thomas Murgatroyd and try to prevale of him to fill up his plase as usual
Third that Moses Wilkinson take the office of secretary till July 1st 1850

Forth that this school be open to all who attend at the age

of five years and not under with their parents be members of this plase.

School meeting Nov-4th 1849 Past that we make by way of subscribtion 5^s for R. Horsfall Kindglering the fires And afterwards to pay him 1^s · 6^d per quarter out of the calection that will be made once a year for that purpose.

to teach in William Smith's place.

At a school meeting held Decem 6th 1849
